

## **Summary/Objective**

The Cellarman is responsible for general brewery cellar activities including product transfers, tank cleaning, product packaging, warehouse activities, and general cleaning for Figueroa Mountain Brewing Co. An emphasis on quality, cleanliness, and efficiency is expected at all times. This position will additionally assist with general upkeep and maintenance of brewery facilities as assigned.

## **Essential Functions**

*Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.*

1. Performs cleaning and sanitation on brewery tanks and vessels as necessary.
2. Performs general cleaning of brewery including equipment, drains, wastewater, floors, piping, outdoor areas, etc...
3. Conducts packaging activities including bottling, canning, and keg cleaning and filling.
4. Assists with overall brewery operations as directed.
5. Using proper PPE, at all times.
6. All other duties as assigned

## **Supervisory Responsibility**

This position has no direct supervisory responsibilities but may serve as a floor leader for other positions in the department.

## **Work Environment**

The Cellarman works in a manufacturing environment with little or no climate control. Some exposure to conditions that are hot, cold, and/or wet may occur. Awareness of your surroundings, personal protective equipment, and proper attire are important to this position.

## **Physical Demands**

*The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.*

The employee is occasionally required to sit; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel, crouch or crawl. Must be able to stand or move for an entire 8-hour shift. The employee must frequently lift and/or move cases of beer up to 25 pounds and 50-pound kegs, and maneuver 150 pound kegs. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and ability to adjust focus.

**Position Type/Expected Hours of Work**

Some flexibility in hours may be allowed, but the employee must be available during the “core” work hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. for the morning shift, or 2:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m. for the evening shift. Weekend work may be required as job duties demand.

**Travel**

This position will not require travel.

**Experience/Education**

- One year of experience in a food or beverage manufacturing environment.
- High school diploma or equivalent degree (GED) required.
- Knowledge of Good Manufacturing Practices

**Additional Eligibility Qualifications**

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must have reliable transportation to and from work
- Must be able to work independently without day to day hands on supervision.
